5. Present Aquinas's and Paley's arguments from design? Why does Hume believe that the argument from design is flawed?
6. How does Freud distinguish between illusion and delusion? If belief in God is an illusion, why does Freud think we should give up this faith?
7. What is Broad's practical postulate? Why does the practical postulate allow Broad to treat religious claims as veridical—with the caveats that religions are likely wrong on many counts and no religion can claim exclusive access to knowledge of the divine?
